Eva Kouka is the Chief of Programs of Tostan. Before joining Tostan, Eva Danty Kouka had been working as Global Program Officer at the Ford Foundation. Her grant making supported Governments' transparency and accountability initiatives and civil society efforts to promote political, social and economic Rights. Prior to joining the Ford Foundation in 2014, Eva Kouka was Regional Program Officer for 11 years with the West Africa Regional Office of Oxfam in Dakar-Senegal. In all these positions, Eva Kouka collaborated closely with senior government officials, private sector, civil society, donors, community leaders to promote human rights, gender equality, youth leadership, natural resource governance, the control of small arms proliferation, and peace building.
